### 24 Waksa Ohi Super Ohgase Big Fire Festival

The fire festival kicks off with the spectacular YOSAKOI dance. After a powerful performance by the local drum team, a torchlight procession starts to move as if it were a fantastic fire river. After that, 'Eternal Flame' is ignited Ohgase big fire, it is finally a climax. When young men stand burning Super Ohgase big fire, which is about 1 ton in weight and about 20 m in height, shake off falling sparks, and spin with the brave cheers of 'Yasser, Yasser', there will be screaming like cheer and storm of applause. The ring of flames emerging in the dark night is a very powerful and fantastic scenery. In the great cheers, fireworks linked with music will light up the river of Aoto when Super Ohgase big fire is laid down. That enchants the audience wrapped in heat. Then, ends 'Super Ohgase big fire festival'. Ohgase big fire festival in the Saburi district, which has a tradition of about 300 years, its motif of Super Ohgase big fire festival.

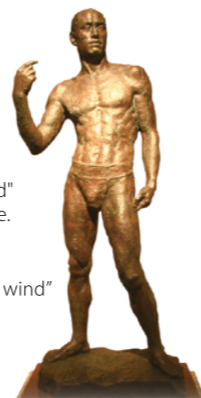

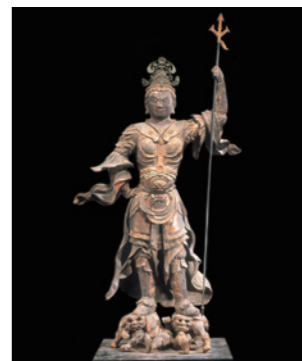

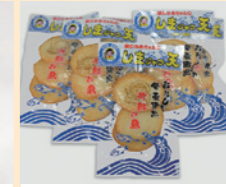
Heshiko Preserved Mackerel
